


WHAT IS A TECHNOLOGICAL DOMAIN?

A domain in which the technical documentation is almost exclusively used by niche professionals.

Examples







PREPARING TO ENTER THE DOMAIN

- Make up your mind
- Start with your resume
- > During the interview/test

WRITING FOR THE DOMAIN

- Do your homework; know your product
- Attend cross-functional meetings
- Focus on conceptual information and end-toend workflows
- Liberally use images
- Use the necessary technical terms; do not over-simplify
- Direct map IDs to concept topics
- Keep your procedure topics short and focused

WRITING FOR THE DOMAIN, CONTD...

- > Use reference topics
- Familiarize yourself with non-UI-based methods to perform a task
- > Use videos
- > Try not to depend on other teams for demos
- Understand what happens after you submit your deliverables

ADDING VALUE

- Act as a virtual customer
- Offer to participate in testing the enhancements for a release
- Offer to function as an SME for the Localization team
- Manage your deliverables end-to-end
