Features in patches!

- 3. Deliver in 3+ weeks, customer tests it, accepts it!
- Feature is merged to a suitable present or future GA release
- 5. Doc team unaware! Even QA team unaware!!

 - ■Content rich
 - Practical
 - ■Tried and tested!

It's about competence

☐ Business is changing fast . Grasp the ability, knowledge (*everybody is doing it*)

Product managers, level 3 support have profuse ability in documentation!

☐ There is no substitute to **competence** to win the trust

Get near to the business Scrum helps!

- ☐ The "pigs" in the Scrum team must feel that "documenter" is a "pig"
- ☐ It will require Passion, Competence and soft skills!
